During Lent we have been getting ready for Easter, keeping our Lenten promises, being thoughtful by doing extra actions with kindness, and using the Lenten calendar to help us learn.

On Friday we will think about what it would be like not to have enough food or water like many children in the world.

You won't need to bring a brain snack – you'll be having a 'simple snack' instead!

We'll put all our koha box money together and send it to Caritas who will use it to help children who are not as lucky as we are at St Ignatius especially children in the Pacific islands.
