

# School Uniform Guidelines

## RATIONALE:

The St. Ignatius Catholic School **compulsory** school uniform is to be worn by all pupils attending the school, to create a sense of belonging and to promote a positive school identity.

## PURPOSES:

- To develop the children's respect for our school's CATHOLIC IDENTITY
- To foster the children's responsibility for their appearance.
- To generously share our CATHOLIC SCHOOL IDENTITY within our Community.

## GUIDELINES:

- The Board of Trustees will review the uniform regularly and will implement changes if required.
- The Board will endeavour to ensure that the prescribed uniform is practical and affordable for parents. It is expected that the correct and full uniform will be worn.
- The Principal has the discretion to assist in cases of financial hardship.
- All clothing and footwear must be clearly labelled with the current owner's name.
- The Principal will advise seasonal change of footwear.
- Regulation sunhats **must be worn** in T1 and T4, and must be **worn as advised** in T2 and T3.
- Regulation Active Wear is required for all children.
- No jackets or raincoats will be worn in the classroom.
- Only a school regulation jacket may be worn. \*
- The regulation uniform is supplied by the School Uniform Centre, 533 Remuera Rd, Remuera.
- The regulation sunhat, and the optional jacket with emblem are available for purchase from the school office.

### BOYS

**Summer:** Regulation dark-navy shorts *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation grey monogrammed short-sleeved shirt\* *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation royal blue monogrammed jersey *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation dark-navy sunhat - purchase at school

**Footwear:** Plain black sandals (no other colour evident)

**Optional:** Dark navy singlet/tanktop worn under shirt, blouse

**Winter:** Clothing as above

**Footwear:** Regulation dark-navy socks, with stripes *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Plain black shoes, sports style acceptable (no other colour evident)  
Lace-up or Velcro fastened

**Optional:** Regulation dark-navy long sleeved under-tee,  
with school name label *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation beanie *as supplied by S.U.C.*

### GIRLS

**Summer:**  
Yr 0 - 3 Regulation dark-navy culottes *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Yr 4 - 6 Regulation dark-navy culottes or skirt *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
*NB Skirts are only for girls in Years 4 – 6)*  
Regulation grey monogrammed short-sleeved blouse\* *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation royal blue monogrammed cardigan *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation dark-navy sunhat - purchase at school

**Footwear:** Plain black sandals (no other colour evident)

**Optional:** Dark navy singlet/tank top worn under shirt, blouse

**Winter:** Clothing as above

**Footwear:** Regulation dark-navy socks *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
or black tights  
Plain black shoes, sports style acceptable (no other colour evident)  
Buckle, lace-up or velcro fastened

**Optional:** Regulation dark-navy long sleeved under-tee,  
with school name label *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation beanie *as supplied by S.U.C.*

## UNISEX

**Active Wear** Regulation royal blue sports shirt *as supplied by S.U.C.*  
Regulation navy sports shorts *as supplied by S.U.C..*

- White or black socks and sports shoes **required only by senior children for sports sessions as advised by their teachers**
- **During Terms 2 and 3 children who change for playtimes may wear their school shoes and socks**

**Rainwear** Either: Regulation School jacket with emblem purchase at school  
Or Regulation plain navy jacket-shell *as supplied by S.U.C.*

Regulation Track pants

- can be worn over uniform in wet/cold weather, and for sporting events purchase at school

**Sunhat** Compulsory, purchase at school.

### Hair Accessories

ONLY plain black hair bands, clips, scrunchies or ribbons may be worn.

### Hair

Children with shoulder length hair **MUST** have it tied back at all times.

**Jewellery** is not permitted with the exception of sleepers or plain stud earrings, and suitable watches (excludes Smiggle watches.)

It's recommended that Year 1 and 2 children do not wear watches.)

Ankle or wrist bracelets, including 'friendship' style bracelets; and necklaces are **not to be worn.**

**Note 1** **\*It's essential that children stay dry - please always send the children with a waterproof jacket they already own, until a school regulation jacket is purchased.**
